COVID-19 Measures When Going Out

COVID-19 is still spreading. We should stay alert and keep taking precautions to stop the spread of the virus.

For example:

- Cover your coughs and sneezes with a mask, a handkerchief, tissues or your elbow.
- Refrain from going out if you have a fever or cold symptoms (even if mild) such as coughing or a sore throat.
- Practice social distancing (keep at least 2 meters away from other people).
- Refrain from visiting facilities in large group.
- Refrain from talking in a loud voice inside facilities.

Also, when you visit facilities, you should take any preventative measures that they ask you to take.

Examples of measures in place in some facilities:

- Asking visitors without a mask to leave
- Temperature checks at the entrance
- Asking visitors to use hand sanitizer before entering
- ★ Measures vary according to facilities, so please follow each facility's measures while using your own judgement and being considerate to the people around you.

Hiroshima Prefecture minimum wage (no change)

広島県最低賃金について (P5)

The hourly minimum wage for each prefecture is updated annually on October 1.

This year, Hiroshima Prefecture's remains unchanged at 871 yen.

The minimum wage applies to all workers who work in Hiroshima Prefecture, regardless of age, gender, form of employment, etc.

Rotavirus vaccine added to routine vaccinations

ロタウイルスワクチンを接種しましょう(P3)

As of October 1, rotavirus is now one of the routine vaccinations for babies. Please vaccinate your child to prevent serious cases of the virus.

What is rotavirus?

Rotavirus is an infectious disease that causes symptoms of acute gastroenteritis (inflammation of the stomach and gut). These can include diarrhea with watery stools. nausea, vomiting, fever, and stomach pain.

Infants from 0 to 6 years of age are especially at risk, and in cases of extreme dehydration, hospitalization may be necessary.

Two vaccines

There are two vaccines, both given orally: Rotarix has two doses and RotaTeq has three doses. They are equally effective. You should use the same vaccine for every dose.

The sooner the better

In the months following their birth, newborns are at greater and greater risk of intussusception, which is when the intestine "telescopes" in on itself. This risk is particularly high after 15 weeks, and is said to be even higher in the 1-2 weeks following a rotavirus vaccination.

You should start your child's rotavirus vaccinations sooner rather than later, in line with other vaccinations that begin at two months.



Babies born on or after August 1, 2020



Bring the following to a medical institution that can provide treatment (e.g. pediatric clinic)

- Maternal and Child Health Handbook
- Vaccination ticket (sesshu ken, sent to all eligible people)

Vaccination ticket: 接種券

• ID that shows your address and date of birth.

Vaccination schedule

The first dose should be between 6 weeks and 14 weeks and 6 days after birth.

Leave at least 27 days between doses.

If vaccinating with Rotarix, complete your child's course of vaccinations before they are 24 weeks old.

If vaccinating with RotaTeq, complete your child's course of vaccinations before they are 32 weeks old.


Subsidized flu vaccines for over-60s

高齢者への助成10月1日から(P3)

Starting from October 1, the following people will pay a 1,600 copayment for flu vaccinations (one time only):

- People aged over 65
- People aged 60 64 who have heart, kidney, respiratory etc. disabilities equivalent to a Level 1 Physical Disability Certificate

People who meet the above criteria, and are also in households receiving Public Assistance (Seikatsu Hogo) or in households exempt from municipal income tax, will pay nothing.



Bring something that proves you are eligible to a hospital or clinic.

> If you are eligible to pay nothing, you will need proof of receiving Public Assistance or proof of payment for Long Term Care Insurance.

If you are not eligible for this support, **please** receive your vaccination after Monday, October 26.

To obtain an ICCH Library Card, you need to bring identification which has your address, and for foreign residents, your period of stay in Japan. (A Japanese driver's license, student identification card, passport or resident card is an acceptable form of identification.)

Assisting with International Cooperation with Used Stamps & PET Bottle Caps

The International Exchange Lounge collects used stamps to assist international cooperation activities. Through the volunteer groups, JOCS*, the collected stamps are sold to collectors to raise money. With the profit, items such as milk and medicine are purchased and doctors as well as nurses are dispatched throughout Asia and other continents. We also collect PET bottle caps in order to support the "Ecocap Action". The sales profits obtained by recycling caps are donated to the Japan Committee "Vaccines for the World's Children" (JCV).

HOW TO COLLECT:

- **Stamps** ⇒ When you cut stamps from envelopes, please leave 5 mm of paper around them. It is not necessary to remove them from the envelope. Torn or folded stamps cannot be accepted.
- **PET Bottle Caps** ⇒ Only PET bottle caps for drinks or mineral water are accepted. Please wash the caps and tear off the sticker if it has one. This is in order to avoid damaging the recycling machines. Things such as metal caps and pull-top tabs cannot be accepted.


Trio-Phone Service

Garbage Disposal Information

Separate garbage properly and take it to the collection site by 8:30 am on the designated day. Please do NOT take garbage to the site on the night before. Garbage collection days vary depending on where you live and the category of the refuse. For further details, consult your local ward office or your neighbors to be sure of the proper disposal method. "Hiroshima 8", a handbook on how to separate garbage, and "Household Waste Disposal Guidelines", a garbage chart with schedules of garbage collection days, are available at ward offices, branch offices and community halls.
