COVID-19 Measures When Going Out

COVID-19 is still spreading. We should stay alert and keep taking precautions to stop the spread of the virus.

For example:

- Cover your coughs and sneezes with a mask, a handkerchief, tissues or your elbow.
- Refrain from going out if you have a fever or cold symptoms (even if mild) such as coughing or a sore throat.
- Practice social distancing (keep at least 2 meters away from other people).
- Refrain from visiting facilities in large group.
- Refrain from talking in a loud voice inside facilities.

Also, when you visit facilities, you should take any preventative measures that they ask you to take.

Examples of measures in place in some facilities:

- Asking visitors without a mask to leave
- Temperature checks at the entrance
- Asking visitors to use hand sanitizer before entering
- ★ Measures vary according to facilities, so please follow each facility's measures while using your own judgement and being considerate to the people around you.

Get necessary care at medical facilities

医療機関で必要な受診を (P3)

You may now feel uncomfortable visiting a hospital because of COVID-19, but avoiding visiting even when necessary may pose health risks.

Fever, cough or abdominal pain may be other illnesses

Fever and other symptoms could be a disease other than COVID-19, so if you refrain from seeing a doctor, you may not get the best treatment.

Also, if you run out of your regular medication, your pre-existing illness may worsen. Make sure to see your doctor on a regular basis.

Symptoms that are difficult to detect

Cancer is said to affect 1 in 2 people. Most are asymptomatic in the early stages.

Regular cancer screenings and checkups will lead to early detection and treatment and prevention of lifestyle-related diseases.

Oral healthcare

Regular oral care can prevent tooth decay and gum disease. For the elderly, it can decrease the risk of aspiration pneumonia.

Book in advance for vaccinations

Some medical facilities offer patients vaccinations at a separate time from other patients to avoid contact with them.

Book an appointment in advance to get your vaccinations.

Self-care can fight COVID-19

Refraining from seeing a doctor on your own self-judgement can make the symptoms of a chronic disease worsen, which may make it impossible to fight against COVID-19.

Consult with your doctor and dentist to manage your health and any pre-existing illnesses properly to combat COVID-19 infections.

Prescriptions by phone or online

You can now receive consultation and be issued prescriptions by phone or online as a special measure against COVID-19.

Assisting with International Cooperation with Used Stamps & PET Bottle Caps

The International Exchange Lounge collects used stamps to assist international cooperation activities. Through the volunteer groups, JOCS*, the collected stamps are sold to collectors to raise money. With the profit, items such as milk and medicine are purchased and doctors as well as nurses are dispatched throughout Asia and other continents. We also collect PET bottle caps in order to support the "Ecocap Action". The sales profits obtained by recycling caps are donated to the Japan Committee "Vaccines for the World's Children" (JCV).

HOW TO COLLECT:

- **Stamps** ⇒ When you cut stamps from envelopes, please leave 5 mm of paper around them. It is not necessary to remove them from the envelope. Torn or folded stamps cannot be accepted.
- **PET Bottle Caps** ⇒ Only PET bottle caps for drinks or mineral water are accepted. Please wash the caps and tear off the sticker if it has one. This is in order to avoid damaging the recycling machines. Things such as metal caps and pull-top tabs cannot be accepted.


Trio-Phone Service

Garbage Disposal Information

Separate garbage properly and take it to the collection site by 8:30 am on the designated day. Please do NOT take garbage to the site on the night before. Garbage collection days vary depending on where you live and the category of the refuse. For further details, consult your local ward office or your neighbors to be sure of the proper disposal method. "Hiroshima 8", a handbook on how to separate garbage, and "Household Waste Disposal Guidelines", a garbage chart with schedules of garbage collection days, are available at ward offices, branch offices and community halls.
