- **1.** There is no course fee. However, students are generally expected to pay for the textbook (1,870 yen) and a Japanese cultural experience (making okonomiyaki, maximum 1,000 yen).
- **2.** The maximum number of students is 15. If we receive more than 15 applications, we will prioritize people who have greater need for Japanese study.
- **3.** As much as possible, we will hold classes in person, while taking appropriate measures to fight the spread of COVID-19. However, if the situation changes, we may be forced to hold classes online via Zoom. Students are responsible for making their arrangements for online learning.
