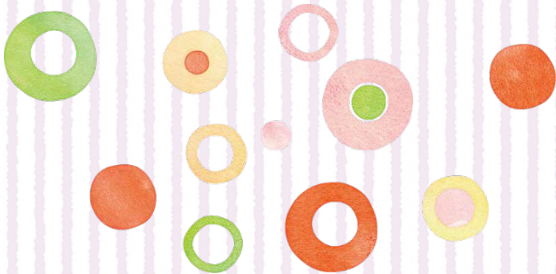

COVID-19 Measures When Going

COVID-19 is still spreading. We should stay alert and keep taking precautions to stop the spread of the virus.

For example:

- Cover your coughs and sneezes with a mask, a handkerchief, tissues or your elbow.
- Refrain from going out if you have a fever or cold symptoms (even if mild) such as coughing or a sore throat.
- Practice social distancing (keep at least 2 meters away from other people).
- Refrain from visiting facilities in large group.
- Refrain from talking in a loud voice inside facilities.

Also, when you visit facilities, you should take any preventative measures that they ask you to take.

Examples of measures in place in some facilities:

- Asking visitors without a mask to leave
- Temperature checks at the entrance
- Asking visitors to use hand sanitizer before entering

★ Measures vary according to facilities, so please follow each facility's measures while using your own judgement and being considerate to the people around you.

Vaccinations to begin in stages for under-65s

64歳以下の人への接種が順次始まります (P1)

From July 1, the City will start sending out vaccination coupons to under-65s in stages.

They should arrive at the address on your residence record (*jūminhyō*) by July 14. (The date of arrival may differ even for multiple people in one household.)

At present, the plan is to allow under-65s to make appointments from July 31, dependent on progress with vaccinations for over-65s.

However, under-65s with underlying health conditions who are eligible for priority vaccination may make appointments from the day they receive their coupons. See

Underlying high conditions on the right for details.

There are no changes to appointment availability for over-65s.

Underlying health conditions

To see if you are eligible for priority vaccination, refer to the notification that will come with your coupon.

Staff will confirm whether you have an underlying condition when you book and when you fill in a questionnaire on the day of your appointment. You do not need to submit proof.

How to book an appointment

1. Receive your coupon in the mail.
2. Check the day when you can book an appointment from.
3. Choose whether to be vaccinated at a medical facility or group vaccination site.

A **Medical institution**
(regular physician, etc.)

B **Group vaccination site**
(at commercial venues, etc.)

4. Make your appointment


A Contact one of the hospitals or clinics on the list enclosed with your coupon directly.

National Health Insurance documents: renewal and applications

国民健康保険の保険証などの交付・更新 (P4)

National Health Insurance Card (Kokumin Kenkō Hoken Shō)

Current National Health Insurance Cards will become invalid on Saturday, July 31.

The City will mail out new cards beginning Wednesday, July 21.

“Payment Limit Certificate” (Gendogaku Tekiyō Nintai Shō)

People with National Health Insurance can apply to receive these certificates.

If your application is accepted, you can show your certificate to hospitals, clinics, etc. when your medical fees are high to pay less.



Current certificates will expire on Saturday, July 31.

To renew, reapply by the end of August. You may have to report your municipal residence tax etc.

Bring your insurance card, your MyNumber and some I.D.

Support for National Pension payments

国民年金保険料には
納付の免除、猶予制度があります(P4)

Are you struggling with National Pension payments for financial reasons?

If so, you can apply for **exemption** from some or all of the payments, or for **deferral**.



If you never make payments, it is possible that you will not be able to receive your basic pension or other benefits when you are older.

 Apply at your local ward office's **National Insurance and Pension Division** (Details below) or at your branch office.

Bring your pension handbook and other documents.

(Students should also bring student I.D.)

Refunds for preschool education and childcare

幼児教育・保育の無償化による

As preschool education and childcare have become partially free, some parents and guardians can ask for refunds. There is an upper limit on the refunded amount.

 Parents or guardians using one of the **Eligible facilities and services** below, who


have received "Facility Use Payment Recognition" (Japanese below).

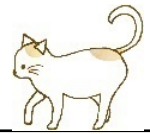

The International Exchange Lounge collects used stamps to assist international cooperation activities. Through the volunteer groups, JOCS*, the collected stamps are sold to collectors to raise money. With the profit, items such as milk and medicine are purchased and doctors as well as nurses are dispatched throughout Asia and other continents. We also collect PET bottle caps in order to support the "Ecocap Action". The sales profits obtained by recycling caps are donated to the Japan Committee "Vaccines for the World's Children" (JCV).

HOW TO COLLECT:

- ☑ **Stamps** ⇒ When you cut stamps from envelopes, please leave 5 mm of paper around them. It is not necessary to remove them from the envelope. Torn or folded stamps cannot be accepted.
- ☑ **PET Bottle Caps** ⇒ Only PET bottle caps for drinks or mineral water are accepted. Please wash the caps and tear off the sticker if it has one. This is in order to avoid damaging the recycling machines. Things such as metal caps and pull-top tabs cannot be accepted.

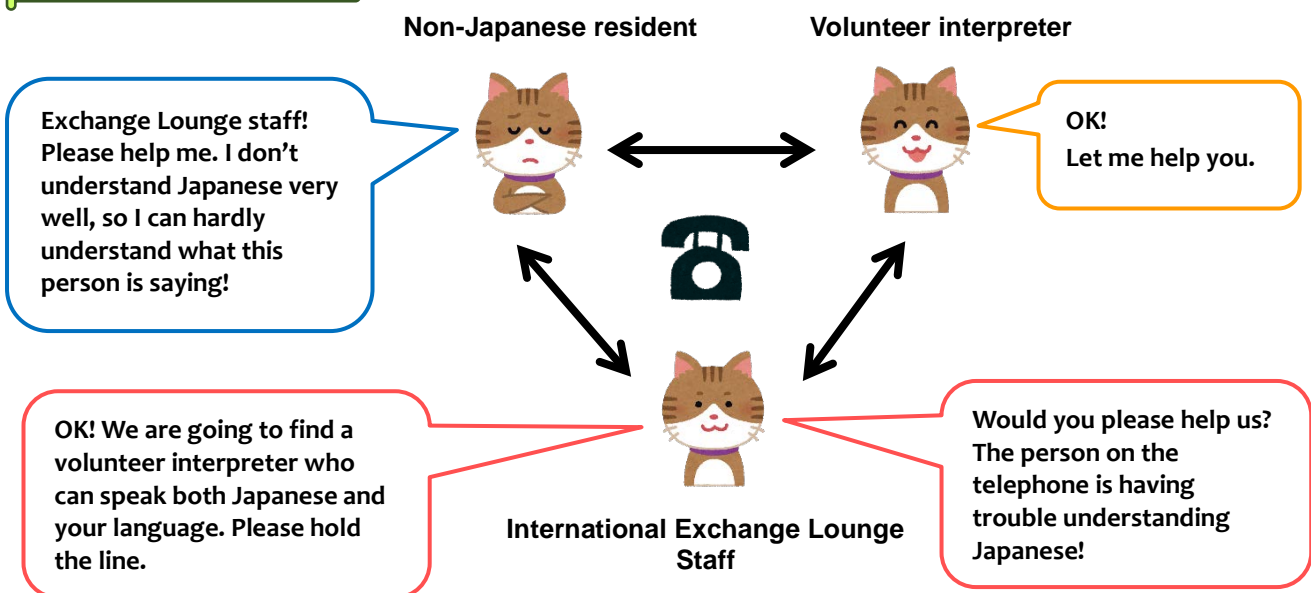

Garbage Disposal Information

Separate garbage properly and take it to the collection site by 8:30 on the designated day. Please do NOT take garbage to the site on the night before. Garbage collection days vary depending on where you live and the category of the refuse. For further details, consult your local ward office or your neighbors to be sure of the proper disposal method. “Hiroshima 8”, a handbook on how to separate garbage, and “Household Waste Disposal Guidelines”, a garbage chart with schedules of garbage collection days, are available at ward offices, branch offices and community halls.
