

COVID-19 is still spreading. We should stay alert and keep taking precautions to stop the spread of the virus.

For example:

- Cover your coughs and sneezes with a mask, a handkerchief, tissues or your elbow.
- Refrain from going out if you have a fever or cold symptoms (even if mild) such as coughing or a sore throat.
- Practice social distancing (keep at least 2 meters away from other people).
- Refrain from visiting facilities in large group.
- Refrain from talking in a loud voice inside facilities.

Also, when you visit facilities, you should take any preventative measures that they ask you to take.

Examples of measures in place in some facilities:

- Asking visitors without a mask to leave
- Temperature checks at the entrance
- Asking visitors to use hand sanitizer before entering
- ★ Measures vary according to facilities, so please follow each facility's measures while using your own judgement and being considerate to the people around you.

After-school childcare for the 2022 school year

来年度の放課後児童クラブの通年利用の受け付け(P4)

Hōkago Jidō Clubs are for elementary school students whose parents need childcare for after school hours and meet certain criteria. Parents and guardians who, due to being away for work etc., need regular childcare after school for elementary school children until around 5:00 pm.

Apply directly to a Children's Community Center (*Jidō Kan*) or Hōkago Jidō Club to use this service for the whole year between the following dates.

For children who will be 1st, 2nd or 3rd grader in April 2022:

Between January 7th (Fri.) and 20th (Thu.)

For children who will be 4th, 5th or 6th grader in April 2022:

Between February 17th (Thu.) and 28th (Mon.)

You can find details on the City's website, including the criteria and necessary documents etc. Recipients will be selected from the pool of applications.

Individuals with a Help Mark, should also be carrying a Help Card in case of emergency situations (received as a set together). The card provides space to list emergency contacts, as well as space to write any information needed (name of condition, care, medications, etc.)

For those who need consultation advice, our centers offer individuals the chance to consult with nursery school teachers, public health nurses, and registered dietitians depending on their needs. There are also open spaces to use, and staff can introduce parents to other child rearing support groups, as well as offer classes on child care.

Health Consultation for Newborns

For new parents who have questions regarding their child's health, including milestones and overall health, we offer consultation services with public health nurses and support staff. 



- **Stamps** ⇒ When you cut stamps from envelopes, please leave 5 mm of paper around them. It is not necessary to remove them from the envelope. Torn or folded stamps cannot be accepted.
- **PET Bottle Caps** ⇒ Only PET bottle caps for drinks or mineral water are accepted. Please wash the caps and tear off the sticker if it has one. This is in order to avoid damaging the recycling machines. Things such as metal caps and pull-top tabs cannot be accepted.


