Using various techniques developed for Yuzen-zome, a wide range of fabrics can be dyed. I became a teacher of Yuzen-zome so I could share Japanese culture with as many people as possible. I hope you'll enjoy learning about this unique dyeing technique!

What is Yuzen-zome?

During the Edo Period (1603-1868), an artist by the name of Yuzen Miyazaki developed a dyeing technique that would allow for various colors and patterns to be dyed onto kimono. By outlining the design with a special type of paste, color could be applied in a wide arrange of designs. During the Meiji Period (1868-1912), a new application was discovered, where a stencil could be used to allow the Yuzen technique to be applied to western style clothing, as well as bags, etc.
