# **Multicultural Services Available at Hiroshima City Libraries**

広島市立図書館の多文化サービスを紹介します

There are 13 municipal libraries in Hiroshima city: Central Library, 8 ward libraries, Children's Library, Manga Library, and Reading Room in Yuki and Asa area respectively.

Among these libraries, 4 libraries offer multicultural services, such as books, newspapers, and magazines printed in a variety of different languages. Books and magazines can even be checked out if desired. (However, the latest issues of magazines, as well as those found at the Central Library cannot be checked out).

In addition to the above, some libraries also offer individuals a chance to experience other cultures by coming to story book readings in various languages.

# Central Library -- Multicultural service counter available

At the Central Library, books written in English, Chinese, Korean, German, French, and Russian are available for individuals to check out. Books include a wide range of topics such as useful information for everyday life, to recent best sellers. There are also resources available for those who are studying Japanese. Flyers and other pamphlets for useful information regarding daily life are free for those who need them.

#### • Children's Library -- Story book readings in various languages

At the Children's Library, there is a vast array of books for individuals to choose from! Their collection currently includes over 5,400 picture books in 40 different languages, which you can use to learn about various countries daily habits and culture. The library also holds several story book reading events, and opportunities for individuals to learn basic greetings and games from other countries throughout the year.

• For those who commute to or live in Hiroshima city and the following surrounding areas, they are able to check out books.

- To check out books, one will need to obtain a library card.

(What can library cards do?)

- They enable you to check out books at any Hiroshima city municipal library.
- A total of 10 books over a 2-week period can be checked out.
- To create or renew a library card, you will need some form of ID to confirm one's name and address. (Residence card, student ID, driver's license, health insurance card, etc.)

#### Returning Books

- Books are able to be returned at any Hiroshima city municipal library.
- Please return books at the designated "Book Return Counter." You do not need your library card when you do so.
- If the library is closed, please use the provided book drop to return books.

# Special fees for visiting large hospitals without a referral (Teigaku Futan Kin)

In the case of not having a medical referral, there are times in which you may have to pay an additional fee, in addition to your regular medical expenses, when consulting with a large-scale medical institution. (However, in the case of emergencies or unavoidable circumstances, the special fees may not apply).

From October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022, the increased rate at Hiroshima City Citizens and Asa Citizens Hospitals are as follows:

#### ■ Fee for first time appointments:

	Until September 30 <sup>th</sup>	From October 1st

Dental	3,300 yen	5,500 yen	

#### ■ Fee for reoccurring patients:

	Until September 30 <sup>th</sup>	From October 1 <sup>st</sup>
Medical	2,750 yen	3,300 yen
Dental	1,650 yen	2,090 yen

# Stop the misuse and abuse of ambulances

救える命を救うために「ひろしま市民と市政」9月1日号(P2)



Ambulances are for helping people in life-threatening situations.

Ambulance and emergency medical services are limited resources. They need to be available so that they can quickly reach people in need.

For individuals who go into cardiac arrest, or have other serious issues, quick and immediate treatment is their only hope. If they can't get access to help within a minute of their symptoms reaching critical need, their survival rate drops.

Please use ambulances appropriately, so that ambulance and emergency medical services can quickly get to people whose lives are in danger.



These conditions are ALWAYS a medical emergency!! Call 119 right away!

#### Face:

Can't move properly or drooping on one side of the face / Slurred speech / Blurry or doubled vision / Extremely pale

#### Chest or back:

Sudden chest pain as well as labored breathing / A feeling of tightness or pressure in your chest that lasts for more than 2 or 3 min. / Pain that seems to move around

#### Head:

Sudden and excruciating headache and high fever / Feelings of giddiness or anxiety.

#### Hands and legs:

Sudden numbness / Weakness in the arms or legs on one side of the body

#### Stomach:

Sudden, extreme pain in the abdomen / Pain that won't go away / Bloody stools or vomiting blood

# Cashless payments for certificate services Available at ward offices

証明手数料のキャッシュレス決済拡充「ひろしま市民と市政」9月1日号 (P3)

When applying for certain certificates at your local ward office, City's Service Corner, municipal tax offices (*Shi Zei Jimusho/Zeimu-shitsu*), as well as the City's Municipal Resident Tax Division (*Shimin Zei Ka*), you are now able to pay the service fee using cashless payment services such as your credit card, online pay apps, transportation IC cards, or electronic money.

- © Receipts are not issued for cashless payments. If you need them, please pay by cash.
- You cannot deposit additional funds to your pre-paid card at the counter.
- You cannot use cashless payment service with cash and/or earned points.
- Tax payment cannot be made using cashless payment service at the counter.
- © Cashless payment services cannot be applied to some certificate services.
