## Multicultural Services Available at Hiroshima City Libraries

広島市立図書館の多文化サービスを紹介します

There are 13 municipal libraries in Hiroshima city: Central Library, 8 ward libraries, Children's Library, Manga Library, and Reading Room in Yuki and Asa area respectively.

Among these libraries, 4 libraries offer multicultural services, such as books, newspapers, and magazines printed in a variety of different languages. Books and magazines can even be checked out if desired. (However, the latest issues of magazines, as well as those found at the Central Library cannot be checked out).

In addition to the above, some libraries also offer individuals a chance to experience other cultures by coming to story book readings in various languages.

## • Central Library -- Multicultural service counter available

At the Central Library, books written in English, Chinese, Korean, German, French, and Russian are available for individuals to check out. Books include a wide range of topics such as useful information for everyday life, to recent best sellers. There are also resources available for those who are studying Japanese. Flyers and other pamphlets for useful information regarding daily life are free for those who need them.

## • Children's Library -- Story book readings in various languages

At the Children's Library, there is a vast array of books for individuals to choose from! Their collection currently includes over 5,400 picture books in 40 different languages, which you can use to learn about various countries daily habits and culture. The library also holds several story book reading events, and opportunities for individuals to learn basic greetings and games from other countries throughout the year.

- To check out books, one will need to obtain a library card.

[What can library cards do?]

- They enable you to check out books at any Hiroshima city municipal library.
- A total of 10 books over a 2-week period can be checked out.
- To create or renew a library card, you will need some form of ID to confirm one's name and address. (Residence card, student ID, driver's license, health insurance card, etc.)

## 🗧 Returning Books

- Books are able to be returned at any Hiroshima city municipal library.
- Please return books at the designated "Book Return Counter." You do not need your library card when you do so.
- If the library is closed, please use the provided book drop to return books.
