Hiroshima City Museum of Contemporary Art Reopens on March 18, 2023

3.18(土) 現代美術館リニューアルオープン ひろしま市民と市政 2月15日号 (P1)

After two years and three months of renovations, the Hiroshima City Museum of Contemporary Art will reopen on March 18. The Museum has improved their accessibility for those in wheelchairs and those with babies and small children during this renovation with the addition of elevators, a multipurpose restroom, and baby care room. The Museum is also open to visitors who only want to visit the museum café or shop.

How to Get There

Take the Hiroshima Maple Loop (Meipuru-pu) sightseeing loop bus from the JR Hiroshima Station, Kamiya-cho, or Heiwa Kinen-koen (Peace Memorial Park) bus stops (the Orange line goes to the Museum).
