The G7 Hiroshima Summit will be held from May 19 to May 21, 2023. The leaders of the G7 member states (France, the United States, the United Kingdom, Germany, Japan, Italy and Canada (in order of rotating presidency)), and the European Union (EU) will gather in Hiroshima. With the G7 Hiroshima Summit, there will be traffic restrictions in place in the city between May 18 and May 22, 2023.
