
Income tax return deadline: Friday, March 15

During this year's final tax return filing (*kakutei-shinkoku*), taxpayers submit a tax return to the tax office to determine their annual income and the tax to be imposed for the 2023 calendar year (January 1 to December 31, 2023). Your FY 2024 residents tax will be calculated based on your finalized 2023 annual income.

Deadlines

- Income tax, recovery special income tax, residents tax (municipal and prefectural), and gift tax Friday, March 15
- Self-employed persons' consumption tax and local consumption tax
 Monday, April 1



Who needs to file tax returns and who is exempt?

The criteria used to determine who needs to file taxes and who does not is extremely personal. If you are uncertain, please contact your local tax office to figure out the best course of action for you (a list of tax offices can be found below).

- If you wish to use either medical expenses or social insurance premiums for income tax deduction purposes, you will need to file a final tax return.
- If it is difficult for you to pay your taxes due to natural disasters or other unavoidable reasons, you may be granted tax collection postponement (*yūyo*) or tax collection reduction/exemption (*genmen*). Please consult with the municipal tax office of your residential area.

Where to get tax forms and what kind of documents are required

The required forms will vary by applicant, so please be sure to check online or at your local tax office for details regarding what sort of forms are needed.

· Income tax return form

Forms for income tax are available on the National Tax Agency's website or at tax offices (*zeimusho*).

· Residents tax return form

Forms for residents tax are available on the official Hiroshima City website or at municipal tax/tax rooms.

My Number (12-digit Individual Number) required!

When filling final tax returns, applicants will need to provide proof of their Individual Number, also known as My Number. You will need to bring either ① or ② below:

- 1 My Number Card (hard, plastic card)
- ② Notification Card or other form that has your number written on it. ID (or a copy of ID) which can be used to prove your identity, such as residence cards, driver's licenses, or national health insurance cards, will also be required.

Note: Only Notification Cards with information, such as name and address, identical to Resident Records (*Jūmin Hyō*) will be accepted.

Online tax returns using the National Tax Agency's e-Tax website

File your tax return online via computer or smartphone! After completing the form, simply send it through the e-Tax system (electronic application) to file. Using this online tax return filing system, you can file your taxes anywhere, anytime! Applications are processed 24 hours/day until March 15. You can also print out your completed form and send it in via postal mail. If you save the data, you will be able to use it as a reference for next year's tax return. Form submission and consultation

1. Income, gift, and consumption taxes

Please submit to your local tax office.

To confirm which office to submit your tax return to, see the Hiroshima Tax Bureau website (Japanese only).

Filing venue at NTT Cred Hall

Between February 16 and March 15, 2024, taxes for Hiroshima (Higashi, Minami, Nishi, Kita Wards), Hatsukaichi, and Kaita should be filed at the following venue. Taxes for Hatsukaichi and Kaita can also be filed at their district taxation office.
